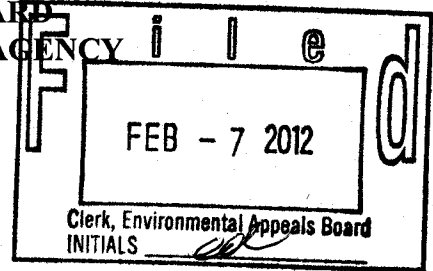

ORDER EXTENDING STAY TO CONTINUE ADR PROCESS

The parties in the above-captioned matter have been participating in the Environmental Appeals Board's Pilot Alternate Dispute Resolution (ADR) program. The Settlement Judge reports that the parties have reached an agreement in principle and require until early March 2012 to finalize their agreement.

Based on the recommendation of the Settlement Judge, the Board hereby extends the stay of this matter until March 16, 2012. The Board expects that Petitioner Amgen Manufacturing, Ltd. will file a motion to dismiss the petition by that date. If further extension of the stay is needed to finalize their agreement, the parties are required to file a joint report explaining the status of their progress and providing justification for a further extension of this stay.


