ORDER GRANTING U.S. ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY, REGION 1'S MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE BRIEF

By motion dated July 3, 2012, U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), Region 1 (Region), seeks an extension of time in which to file its response brief in the above-captioned matter. Pursuant to 40 C.F.R. § 22.30(a)(2), the Region's response to the appeal brief filed by Munce's Superior Petroleum Products, Inc. (MSPPI), is due within twenty days of service of the appeal, or July 9, 2012. The Region now seeks to extend the response brief filing deadline to July 30, 2012. MSPPI does not object to the Region's motion.

In support of its motion, the Region states that the "legal questions presented in this appeal pertain entirely to issues of bankruptcy law, not to issues of environmental law. Thus, EPA requires greater than the standard 20 days to thoroughly respond to Appellant's claims." Motion at 1-2. According to the Region, the additional time is sought also "to coordinate with various offices within EPA Headquarters to construct and present to the Environmental Appeals Board a cohesive response to Appellant's claims." *Id.* at 2.

For good cause shown, the Board grants the Region's request for an extension of time to file its brief. Accordingly, the Region shall file its brief on or before July 30, 2012.
