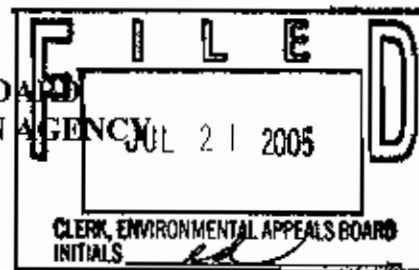

**ORDER GRANTING JOINT MOTION
FOR STAY OF PROCEEDINGS**

On July 19, 2005, Region I of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, along with Timothy A. Watts and Douglas H. Watts, petitioners, filed a joint motion to stay the proceedings in the above-captioned matter. At present, Region I's response to the petition for review is due to be filed with the Environmental Appeals Board on Monday, July 25, 2005. In their motion, the parties report that they have entered into settlement negotiations and believe there is a substantial likelihood the issues raised in the petition may be resolved without having to resort to litigation. They therefore request that these proceedings be stayed until September 18, 2005, by which date they would submit a status report on the progress of the settlement discussions.

For good cause shown, the parties' joint motion is hereby **GRANTED**. Region I's July 25, 2005 filing deadline is rescinded, and the parties are directed to provide the Board with a report, on or before **September 18, 2005**, describing the status of settlement negotiations in this case and suggesting a future course of action.


