

ORDER GRANTING SECOND JOINT MOTION

TO STAY THE PETITION

On September 28, 2006, the parties in the above-captioned matter, U.S. EPA Region IV (the "Region") and South Carolina Electric & Gas, filed a second joint motion requesting to stay the proceedings in this case until November 30, 2006. On August 28, 2006, the Environmental Appeals Board ("Board") issued an order granting the parties' request to stay the proceedings and extend the Region's deadline to file its response to the petition until September 29, 2006. In their first request, the parties explained that they had engaged in discussions and that additional time was necessary to work toward resolution of the issues South Carolina Electric & Gas raised in its petition. In support of their second request, the parties explain that they have negotiated a proposed

modification to Permit No. SC00457752 (the permit object of this

appeal), which should resolve the issues raised in the petition.

The parties further explain that the Region is preparing a Notice

of Permit Modification that will be published reflecting the

proposed modification(s) and absent any challenges or delays the

Region expects the permit to be issued by December 22, 2006. The

parties also represent that they will report to the Board on the

status of the modification by October 30, 2006.

For good cause shown, the Board hereby grants the parties'

request to stay the proceedings until November 29, 2006. If the

parties do not reach resolution of the matters raised in the

petition by such date, the Region must then file a response to the

petition no later than November 30, 2006.

So ordered.
