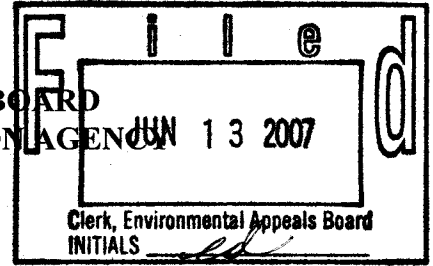

**ORDER GRANTING LEAVE FOR THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA  
WATER AND SEWER AUTHORITY TO WITHDRAW AS PETITIONER  
AND FOR THE DISTRICT GOVERNMENT TO SUBSTITUTE COUNSEL**

On June 7, 2007, the District of Columbia Water and Sewer Authority ("WASA") filed a motion seeking leave to withdraw as a petitioner in the above-captioned appeal. WASA reports that its duties as the District of Columbia's municipal separate storm sewer system storm water administrator have been transferred to a newly created Department of the Environment in the executive branch of the Government of the District of Columbia. WASA states that as a result of this reorganization, it no longer needs to be separately identified in the petition for review of the subject permit. The District Government and WASA filed another motion on June 7, 2007, seeking leave to remove Bruce Brennan as counsel of record for the District and to substitute Caroline Burnett in his place, and also to allow WASA's general counsel, Avis Marie Russell, to withdraw as counsel. The motions are hereby **GRANTED**.
