

**ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION OF TIME**

On August 30, 2007, United States Environmental Protection Agency, Region 8 (“Region”) issued a prevention of significant deterioration (“PSD”) permit (number PSD-OU-0002-04.00) to Deseret Power Electric Cooperative (“Deseret”) for the construction of a new waste-coal-fired electric generating unit at Deseret’s existing Bonanza Power Plant, located near Bonanza, Utah. On November 21, 2007, the Board granted in part Sierra Club’s petition, pursuant to 40 C.F.R. § 124.19(a), for review of the Region’s decision to issue the PSD permit. The Board granted review as to one of the two issues raised in Sierra Club’s petition and held the other issue under advisement. The Board established a briefing schedule for the issue for which it had granted review that included a deadline of January 31, 2008, for opening briefs from Sierra Club and any supporting amici, a deadline of February 21, 2008, for response briefs from the Region, Deseret, and any supporting amici, and a deadline of March 6, 2008, for reply briefs. The Board received an opening brief from the Sierra Club and six amicus briefs (hereinafter the “Opening Briefs”).


Before the Board at this time is Deseret’s motion for an extension of the deadline for

filing briefs in response to the Opening Briefs. Deseret requests an extension because, among other things, Deseret states that the amicus briefs raise several new legal arguments and introduce a substantial amount of additional factual, scientific, and technical information. In addition, Deseret states that its receipt of several of the amicus briefs was delayed. Deseret represents that Sierra Club consents to this motion.

Upon consideration and for good cause shown, Deseret's request for an extension of time is hereby granted. Accordingly, briefs in response to the Opening Briefs are due on or before Friday, March 21, 2008. In addition, the deadline for those persons who filed Opening Briefs to file briefs in reply to the response briefs is also hereby extended. Reply briefs shall be filed on or before Friday, April 11, 2008. As provided in the November 21, 2007 Order Granting Review, reply briefs shall not exceed 20 pages and are limited to arguments presented in responses filed by the March 21 deadline.

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
