

ORDER CONSOLIDATING PETITIONS FOR REVIEW AND GRANTING LEAVE TO PARTICIPATE

Before the Board are three petitions for review filed by:¹ 1) Bill MacClarence, P.E.; 2) The North Slope Bureau ("NSB"), Inupiat Community of the Arctic Slope, and the Alaska Eskimo Whaling Commission (collectively "NSB"); and 3) Resisting Environmental Destruction on Indian Land ("REDOIL"), the Alaska Wilderness League, Center for Biological Diversity, Natural Resources Defense Council, Northern Alaska Environmental Center, and Pacific Environment (collectively "REDOIL").² These parties petition for review of a minor-source permit issued by U.S. EPA Region 10 (the "Region") to Shell Offshore, Inc. ("SOI"). Among other things, the permit authorizes air emissions from a single drill ship (the Kulluk Drilling Unit) that will attach to the sea floor off the North Slope of Alaska for the purpose of oil exploration. The issuance of the OCS permit is governed by 40 C.F.R. part 55 and the procedural rules set forth in 40 C.F.R. part 124. *See*

40 C.F.R. § 55.6(a)(3). For administrative purposes, the Board hereby consolidates the three petitions for review in this matter.

By motion filed with the Board on July 30, 2008, SOI seeks leave to participate in the proceedings and to respond to the above-mentioned petitions for review. SOI's request is granted. SOI's response to the petitions must be filed with the Board no later than August 22, 2008. The Petitioners may file reply briefs to the Region's and SOI's response briefs on or before September 5, 2008. Any such replies shall be limited to issues raised in the Region's or SOI's briefs and shall not introduce new issues or arguments not presented in the Petitioners' respective petitions.
