## ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE REPLY BRIEF

By motion filed January 29, 2007, Respondent J. Phillip Adams ("Respondent") has requested an additional extension of time of "not less than twenty-one days" in which to file a reply to the notice of appeal and appeal brief filed January 17, 2007, by Complainant-Appellant U.S. EPA Region 10 ("Region") in the above-captioned proceeding. Respondent's reply brief is currently due on February 6, 2007, pursuant to our procedural rules. *See* 40 C.F.R. § 22.30(a)(2).<sup>1</sup>

In support of its motion, Respondent notes that it is not "reasonable or possible" for it to meet the reply brief deadline in light of "the number of issues raised by Complainant on appeal, the length of Complainant's Brief, the relatively short time to file a Reply Brief, and [the] heavy workload of Respondent's counsel." Respondent further states that "neither party will be prejudiced by the requested extension," observing that the instant case "has been pending since

the Administrative Complaint was filed June 16, 2004." Finally, the Respondent represents that the Region has expressed to Respondent that the Region does not oppose Respondent's motion.

For good cause shown, Respondent's request is hereby granted. Consistent with Respondent's request, Respondent has an additional three weeks, until Tuesday, February 27, 2007, to file its reply brief in the instant matter. Respondent's reply brief must be received by the EAB on or before this date.

So ordered.
