Under 40 C.F.R. § 124.19(k), South Essex Sewerage District (“SESD”) hereby moves to dismiss its Petition for Review of its NPDES Permit in this matter (“Appeal”). EPA Region 1 assents to this request.

As noted in prior status updates, the parties have reached a settlement agreement to resolve the Appeal. Region 1 has now issued a draft permit modification for public notice and satisfied Region 1’s obligations under the settlement agreement. Consistent with the terms of the settlement agreement, SESD now moves to dismiss the Appeal in its entirety.
