#### STATUS REPORT

In its Second Order Staying Proceedings and Order Scheduling Status Conference (June 21, 2007), the U.S. Environmental Appeals Board directed U.S. EPA Region 1 ("Region") to file a status report on the progress of settlement discussions in the above-captioned matter no later than August 8, 2007.

The Region, the Town of North Attleborough and the Rhode Island Department of Environmental Management ("DEM") have reached an agreement to resolve the contested phosphorus and nitrogen conditions in the permit. This agreement is contingent upon the parties successfully resolving their dispute over the calculation of permit's metals limits. The Region has outlined its position on this issue, which the parties are actively considering. Given the significant progress made with respect to the highly contentious nutrient-related issues on appeal, and the delay and uncertainty that would result should the parties fail to successfully address their few remaining differences, the parties believe the prospects for settlement remain strong.

Counsel for the Town and DEM have assented to this status report.
