THIRD JOINT STATUS REPORT

On June 10, 2021, the Environmental Appeals Board granted the Environmental Protection Agency Region 8's Motion to Stay in the above-captioned case. The Board stayed this matter, subject to conditions, "until such time as the D.C. Circuit renders a decision disposing of the challenge to NHPA compliance in connection with the Dewey-Burdock Project that is pending before the Court." Order Granting Motion to Stay Subject to Conditions at 5 (June 10, 2021). The Board conditioned the stay on the parties' filing periodic joint status reports addressing the status of the D.C. Circuit litigation, "including the status of the NHPA issues under review and any other information that the parties believe may be relevant to the petition pending before the Board." *Id.* at 5-6. Further, the parties are to "apprise the Board within two weeks of any decision by the D.C. Circuit relevant to the NHPA issue or other issues potentially affecting the Board adjudication of the pending petition," or "of any settlement involving issues presented in the petition pending before the Board." *Id.* at 6. The Order further stated: "the Board may lift the stay or take other appropriate action in this matter prior to conclusion of the D.C. Circuit litigation, or at any other time in accordance with the Board's responsibility to manage its docket." *Id.*

The parties in the D.C. Circuit litigation filed their final briefs on July 22, 2021. The Oglala Sioux Tribe (Petitioner), Nuclear Regulatory Commission (Respondent), and Powertech (USA) Inc. (Intervenor-Respondent) briefs all address National Historic Preservation Act (NHPA) issues. Oral argument occurred on November 9, 2021. The case has been submitted and a decision by the Court is pending.

On June 24, 2021, in the state permit proceedings, the State of South Dakota's Department of Agriculture and Natural Resources Water Management Board (State Board) issued an order stating that Powertech's contested Motion to Amend Procedural Order was to be argued at the State Board's meeting on October 6-7, 2021. Following the meeting, the State Board adopted a motion to deny Powertech's request to amend the Procedural Order. A draft Order reflecting that decision will be considered at a hearing by the Water Management Board on December 8, 2021. The filings in that matter, including the November 17, 2021 Notice of Hearing that includes a copy of the draft Order, may be accessed at the agency website:

The parties have not come to settlement on any of the issues presented in the petition, and do not have any new information relevant to the petition to report to the Board. In accordance with the Board's June 21 Order, the parties will inform the Board within two weeks of any relevant decision in the D.C. Circuit matter or of any settlement involving the issues presented in the Petition.
