

Intervenor District of Columbia Water and Sewer Authority ("WASA") hereby moves for an extension of time to file its response to the in the captioned petition for review filed by Friends of the Earth and Sierra Club ("Petitioners").


On June 15, 2007, the Environmental Appeals Board ("EAB" or "Board") granted WASA's motion to intervene and directed that WASA file a response to Petitioners' petition on June 28, 2007, which is the same deadline provided to the Environmental Protection Agency ("EPA") for EPA's response. On June 25, 2007, EPA filed a motion seeking an extension of time to file its response until July 6, 2007.

To the extent the Board grants EPA's motion, WASA requests an extension until July 6, 2007 so that both EPA's and WASA's responses will be filed on the same date. WASA contacted counsel for EPA and Friends of the Earth/Sierra Club and they consent to this extension.
