

The County of Sonoma and Sonoma County Water Agency ("County") respectfully withdraw their petition for review of NPDES Permit Number CA0005241 ("Permit"), which the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, Region Nine issued to the Dry Creek Rancheria Band of Pomo Indians ("Permittee") on April 30, 2007. The County and Permittee have negotiated a comprehensive Memorandum of Agreement intended to address the County's concerns about the Permit, among other things.

The County appreciates the Environmental Appeals Board's granting of multiple briefing extensions to allow the parties to negotiate the Memorandum of Agreement. The extensions facilitated the parties' negotiations toward a final agreement.
