APPELLEE'S UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE ITS RESPONSES TO APPELLANTS'/RESPONDENTS' APPEAL BRIEFS

Pursuant to 40 C.F.R. §§ 22.16(b) and 22.30(e) of the Consolidated Rules of Practice Governing the Administrative Assessment of Civil Penalties, Issuance of Compliance or Corrective Action Orders, and the Revocation, Termination or Suspension of Permits, ("Consolidated Rules" or "CROP"), the United States Environmental Protection Agency, Region 5 ("Appellee/Complainant"), files the instant Appellee's Motion for an Extension of Time to File Its Responses to Respondents'/Appellants', E. J. Klockenkemper's and Respondent/Appellant's, Rocky Well Service, Inc.'s appeal briefs.

On or about October 31, 2008, Appellant/Respondent Klockenkemper filed his 221-page appellate brief, ("Appellant Klockenkemper's Brief"), after having been granted two separate extensions of time by the Environmental Appeals Board ("EAB" or "the Board"). On or about October 30, 2008, Appellant/Respondent Rocky Well Service, Inc. submitted for filing its 5-page appellate brief, ("Appellant Rocky Well's Brief"), pursuant to the two extensions of time granted it by the EAB.

On November 4, 2008, Appellee's counsel, Mary McAuliffe indicated to the undersigned

that she had spoken on the telephone with Felipe Gomez, Esq., counsel for Appellant/
Respondent Klockenkemper, on that day. According to Ms. McAuliffe, Mr. Gomez indicated to her in the telephone conversation that he had previously spoken with Richard Day, Esq., counsel for Appellant/Respondent Rocky Well, regarding additional time for Appellee/Complainant to respond to their briefs, and that Appellants/Respondents agreed that they had no objection to a motion by Appellant/Complainant seeking a 60-day extension of time to respond to their appeal briefs.

Given the sheer volume of Appellant/Respondent Klockenkemper's brief,

Appellee/Complainant will require more than the twenty days allowed under the CROP,

40 C.F.R. § 22.30(a)(2), to respond, and a 60-day extension would allow Appellee/Complainant sufficient time to evaluate and address the issues raised by Appellant/Respondent. In addition, because Appellee/Complainant will need to devote a substantial amount of time and effort to respond to Appellant/Respondent Klockenkemper's brief, it anticipates that it will need more than the twenty days provided for the CROP to address the issues in Appellant/Respondent Rocky Well's brief. A 60-day extension of time will provide Appellee/Complainant with the time to properly respond to the issues raised by Appellant/Respondent Rocky Well in its brief.

Lastly, because of the number of holidays that occur during November, December and January, and the personal commitments of Appellee's/Complainant's counsel and its management during this holiday period, a 60-day extension of time would not be unreasonable under the circumstances.

For the reasons set forth above, Appellee/Complainant respectfully requests that the EAB grant its motion for an additional 60 days to file its response briefs to Appellant's/Respondent's

Klockenkemper's and Appellant's/Respondent's Rocky Well's appeal briefs, and issue an order setting a new deadline for the filing of Appellee's/Complainant's response briefs.1
