#### MOTION TO STAY PROCEEDINGS

Region 1 ("Region") of the United States Environmental Protection Agency (the Respondent), with the assent of the Town of Jaffrey, New Hampshire (the permittee and Petitioner), respectfully requests that the Environmental Appeals Board ("Board") stay the proceedings in the above-captioned matter until March 24, 2010, to allow the parties to undertake settlement negotiations.

#### BACKGROUND

The Region reissued NPDES Permit No. NH0100595 ("Permit") to Petitioner on September 28, 2009. On November 2, 2009, Petitioner filed a petition for review with the Board contesting certain conditions of the Permit. By letter dated November 6, 2009, the Board directed the Region to prepare a response that addresses Petitioner's contentions and whether Petitioner has satisfied the requirements for obtaining review.

Upon consideration of the permitting documents and the petition for review, as well as subsequent developments after the filing of the petition, the parties believe that resolution of at least some of the issues in this appeal is possible, and have agreed to enter into settlement discussions.

REQUESTED RELIEF AND GROUNDS FOR SUCH RELIEF

The Region requests that the Board rescind the December 21, 2009 deadline for filing of

the Region's response to the petition for review and stay the proceedings by three months. The

Region proposes to submit a status report no later than March 24, 2010, advising whether the

Board should further extend the stay, establish a revised schedule for the litigation, or take other

appropriate action.

An extension of this length is reasonable and necessary given the need to develop

technical information to resolve the issues presented, the need to schedule discussions between

personnel from the Region and Petitioner (including during the traditional holiday month of

December), and the need to consult with the New Hampshire Department of Environmental

Services. If a stay is not granted, the parties will be forced to divert their time and effort to the

proceedings before this Board, when there is a substantial possibility that at least some of the

issues raised in the petition for review may be resolved through settlement discussions.

Accordingly, in an effort to conserve administrative and judicial resources, and to encourage

efficiency and promote judicial economy, the Region, with the assent of Petitioner, requests that

the Board grant this motion and stay all proceedings in this matter until March 24, 2010.

The Region represents that its undersigned counsel has discussed this Motion for Stay of

Proceedings with Petitioner's counsel and that Petitioner assents to the motion.
