Dear Ms. Durr:

On October 21, 2008, I submitted a request to reschedule Oral Argument due to a previously scheduled trip that will have me out of the United States on December 4, 2008. I suggested that I could comply with a timeframe between November 25<sup>th</sup> and December 1, 2008. Subsequently, I received communication by e-mail from three of the litigants, Mr. Chris Winter, Ms. Sarah Bordelon and Ms. Kristi Smith, saying that their personal plans for this period precluded their support of my request. I then proposed that I could return to the United States early so that I would be available for Oral Argument on or after December 12, 2008. 
