| The U.S. Environmental Protecti | on Agency ("Complainant") moves for an |

Respondent's Brief has raised a number of issues, particularly with regard to the scope of the Agency's authority under Section 308 of the Clean Water Act, that concern several offices within EPA, including the Office of General Counsel and the Office of Civil Enforcement.
