
Dear Sir or Madam:

Attached are Raytheon's Discharge Monitoring Reports (DMRs) for November, 1995. We are pleased to report all parameters were within permit limitations.

No blank DMR's for Outfall 001A were included in the 1995 package of blank forms from your agency. As previously reported in a letter to your agency, discharges from this outfall ceased in early 1992, and the outfall was sealed. Therefore, no DMRs have been submitted for Outfall 001A.

Also please note that as of November 30, 1995 the treatment plant was shut down and the discharge of treated sanitary wastewater (Outfall 002A) was ceased. As discussed with personnel in your agency, this is because Raytheon is shutting down the Wayland facility and the population and wastewater loadings from the remaining workers have been reduced to levels that make it unpractical to treat and discharge. At present the only remaining wastewater discharges regulated under NPDES permit #MA0001511 are boiler blowdown and intermittent cooling water from the facility heating and cooling systems. We are currently implementing a scheme that would eliminate these discharges as well. We anticipate that this will occur before the end of the year. At that time, we will inform you of this in writing and request a change in the status of our NPDES permit.
