The State of Illinois (“Illinois”), by and through Illinois Attorney General Lisa Madigan, hereby requests an extension of time to file a Response to the Petition for Review (hereinafter “Petition”) filed by the Sierra Club, in the above-referenced matter. In support thereof, Illinois states as follows:

1. This matter was received in the Office of the Illinois Attorney General on February 8, 2011.

2. The permitting agency continues to prepare the certified index of the administrative record, which after completion and review by the Office of the Illinois Attorney General, will be filed with the Board.

3. In light of these circumstances and the technical issues raised by the Petition, Illinois will not be able to meet the Board’s March 15, 2011, deadline for filing a Response to the Petition.

4. Illinois respectfully requests an extension to and until Friday April 15, 2011, to file the Certified Index to the Record and a Response to the Petition.

5. Counsel for both the Sierra Club has been consulted and does not object to the

extension of time.

WHEREFORE, the State of Illinois respectfully requests that the Board grant this Motion for Extension of Time and set a filing deadline no earlier than Friday April 15, 2011 for the Certified Index to the Record and Response to Petition.
