In its Order dated April 20, 2012, the Board instructed the Region to file its response brief to Petitioner Idaho River United's (IRU's) appeal of the of the City of Boise's NPDES permits for Lander Street and West Boise sewage treatment plants by June 5, 2012. In light of the pending motion to withdraw the appeals, which IRU filed on May 31, 2012, the Region respectfully requests an extension of time to file its response. In a separate filing today with the Board, the Region states its non-opposition to Petitioner's Motion to Withdraw the appeals. If the Board grants IRU's Motion to Withdraw, no response brief would be due. If the motion is denied, the Region requests an additional 45 days from the denial of the Motion to Withdraw to prepare its response brief.


