Dear Members of the Board:

On behalf of the Indiana Municipal Power Agency ("IMPA"), the Missouri Joint Municipal Electric Utility Commission ("MJMEUC"), the Northern Illinois Municipal Power Agency ("NIMPA"), Soyland Power Cooperative, Inc. ("Soyland"), Wolverine Power Supply Cooperative ("Wolverine"), the Kentucky Municipal Power Agency ("KMPA"), and, since our January 26, 2006 letter, Wisconsin Public Power Inc. ("WPPI") (collectively, the "Public Power Participants"), we write to express our opposition to a request filed by the Petitioners to file a brief responding to the March 7, 2006 brief of the Environmental Protection Agency. As noted in Petitioners' request, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency and Intervenor Prairie State Generating Company, LLC also oppose this request.

The Public Power Participants first wrote of the need for expeditious review of this PSD permit in our Motion for Leave to File a Brief as Amici Curiae on July 28, 2005. Seven and a half months now have elapsed since then, and we once again are compelled to alert the Board to the urgency of our situation. The Public Power Participants respectfully request that the Board deny Petitioners' request and move to a decision on the Prairie State permit as soon as possible.

Any further delay of the Prairie State project jeopardizes its completion in time to meet the real energy needs of the Public Power Participants' over one million customers in Indiana,
