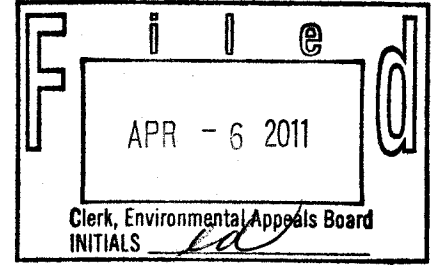

**ORDER SCHEDULING ORAL ARGUMENT**

The Environmental Appeals Board has determined that oral argument may be of assistance in its deliberations of the above-captioned matter. Accordingly, the parties are ordered to participate in oral argument beginning at 10:30 a.m. EDT on Tuesday, May 24, 2011, in the Administrative Courtroom, U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, EPA East Building, Room 1152, 1201 Constitution Avenue, N.W., Washington, D.C. The Board has allocated sixty (60) minutes total for this oral argument, divided as follows: thirty (30) minutes for WildEarth Guardians, twenty (20) minutes for U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, Region 8, and ten (10) minutes for BP America Production Company. At the outset of proceedings, WildEarth Guardians may reserve up to five (5) minutes of its allocated time for rebuttal.

The parties shall notify the Clerk of the Board in writing by Tuesday, May 17, 2011, of the names of those who will present argument. The Administrative Courtroom is equipped with video-conferencing equipment and, accordingly, either party may participate in the oral argument by video conference without attending in person. Counsel or other duly authorized

representatives for the parties who wish to participate in this oral argument via video-conferencing shall contact the Clerk of the Board, at 202-233-0122, no later than Thursday, May 17, 2011, to make arrangements for the use of the video conference equipment.
