Based on this representation the Board hereby grants the request to substitute the petitioner of record; for convenience, however, the Board retains the original caption in this case.

For good cause shown, Petitioner's request to dismiss NPDES Appeal No. 05-15 is granted. The Board hereby dismisses the appeal in its entirety with prejudice.
