MOTION OF OPENLANDS FOR LEAVE TO FILE A BRIEF AS AMICUS CURLAE IN SUPPORT OF PETITIONERS

Pursuant to 40 C.F.R. § 124.19 and the Environmental Appeals Board Practice
Manual § III.D.7, Openlands (formerly known as Openlands Project) respectfully moves
the Environmental Appeals Board for leave to file the accompanying brief as *amicus*curiae supporting the petition for review filed by the American Lung Association of
Metropolitan Chicago, Citizens Against Ruining the Environment, the Clean Air Task
Force, Lake County Conservation Alliance and the Sierra Club ("Petitioners"). The
petition for review challenges the decision by the Illinois Environmental Protection
Agency ("IEPA") to issue a Prevention of Significant Deterioration ("PSD") permit to
Indeck-Elwood, LLC ("Indeck") for the construction of a 660-megawatt coal-burning
power plant in Elwood, Illinois, immediately adjacent to the 19,000 acre Midewin
National Tallgrass Prairic.

Founded in 1963, Openlands is a non-profit member-based corporation dedicated to preserving and enhancing public open space in the greater Chicago metropolitan region. Openlands was a primary partner in the establishment of the Midewin National Tallgrass Prairie, the largest protected open space in northeastern Illinois and the first

national tallgrass prairie preserve in the United States. An important function of Openlands continues to be the protection of the Midewin.

Openlands' accompanying brief as amicus curiae describes the value of the Midewin National Tallgrass Prairie and explains the importance of allowing the public to comment on the new information that has come to light as part of the Endangered Species Act consultation process. The consultation process produced volumes of new information on the adverse and potentially irreparable environmental impacts that Indeck's proposed project will have on the Midewin. The public never had a chance to review and provide valuable input on this new information because the consultation process was not completed until after the comment period for this permit was closed. Accordingly, Openlands respectfully requests this Board to review the enclosed amicus brief and to consider it when issuing a decision in this matter.
