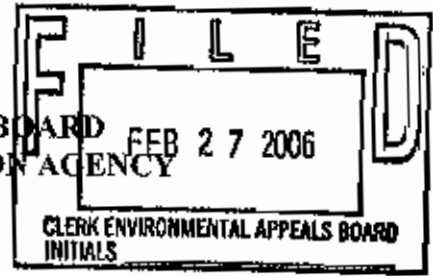

**ORDER DISMISSING PETITION FOR REVIEW**

On February 27, 2006, Region VIII of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency and Western Resource Advocates filed a joint motion to dismiss the above-captioned appeal. In the motion, the parties explain that the Region withdrew the Underground Injection Control ("UIC") permit at issue in the case in its entirety, pursuant to 40 C.F.R. § 124.19(d), so that the Region could undertake additional procedures related to the National Historic Preservation Act for issuance of a new UIC permit. The parties note that as a result of this withdrawal, the petition for review of the withdrawn UIC permit is now moot. They therefore request dismissal of the petition.

For good cause shown, the petition for review, designated as Environmental Appeals Board UIC Appeal No. 05-02, is hereby **DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE**.
