#### STATUS REPORT AND MOTION TO EXTEND THE STAY OF PROCEEDINGS

Region 1 of the Environmental Protection Agency ("EPA" or the "Region"), Respondent, respectfully submits to the Environmental Appeals Board ("Board") this status report and motion to extend the stay of proceedings related to the petition for review filed by the Conservation Law Foundation ("CLF") in the above-referenced appeal. The parties have reached an agreement in principle on all issues raised by the appeal. However, as explained below, a brief additional stay of the proceedings is necessary to enable the City of Portsmouth ("City") to obtain approval of the agreement from the City Council. Counsel for CLF and the City have assented to this motion.

On December 3, 2007, the Board granted the Region's fourth request for a stay of proceedings based on the parties' having reached an agreement in principle on one issue and their ongoing negotiations to resolve the remaining issues. The Board ordered the parties to provide, on or before December 21, 2007, a report describing the status of settlement negotiations and suggesting a future course of action.

Since the date of the last status report, the parties have reached an agreement in principle on all issues raised by the appeal. The City's counsel has informed the Region that City representatives will present the agreement to the City Council for final authorization on January 14, 2008. CLF's counsel has informed the Region that upon signature of the agreement by the City, it will move to dismiss the petition for review no later than January 18, 2008.

The Region, with the assent of counsel for CLF and the City, requests an extension of the stay of proceedings until January 18, 2008 to provide time for the City to obtain final approval of the agreement and for CLF to file its motion to dismiss.
