Notice of Proposal to Issue Final Permit; Request for Public Comment and Opportunity for a Public Hearing

The U. S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), Region III, has developed a draft final Underground Injection Control (UIC) permit (PAS2D010 BVEN) for Stonehaven Energy LLC. This draft final permit was developed under the authority of the UIC regulations at 40 CFR Parts 124, 144, 146, and 147, for the purpose of constructing and operating one Class II-D injection well to dispose of fluids produced solely in association with Stonehaven Energy's oil and gas Tippery Field production operations located in Venango County, PA. Stonehaven Energy plans to dispose of these fluids through an injection well, the Latshaw #9, into the Speechley Formation located in the Tippery Field in Cranberry Township, Venango County, Pennsylvania. A permit is required to meet the provisions of the EPA administered UIC Program in Pennsylvania.

The Administrative Record for this permit action remains available for public inspection during normal business hours at the Office of Ground Water and Enforcement in the Office of Drinking Water and Source Water Protection (3WWP22) of EPA Region III, 1650 Arch Street, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania 19103. All information submitted by the applicant, unless deemed confidential, is available to the public in the Administrative Record. The Administrative Record includes the permit application, draft permit, statement of basis, public notice and all related correspondence. A copy of the information listed above is available for review and inspection at the Oil City Library, 2 Central Ave., Oil City, Pennsylvania 16301-2795.

NOTICE: The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency has developed a draft final Underground Injection Control (UIC) permit PAS2D010BVEN for Stonehaven Energy Management LLC (Stonehaven Energy) under the authority of the UIC regulations at 40 CFR Parts 124, 144, 146, and 147. The permit is necessary for the construction and operation of one Class II-D injection well, the Latshaw #9, to dispose of produced fluids, produced solely in association with Stonehaven Energy's oil or gas production operations.

DESCRIPTION: Stonehaven Energy submitted a UIC permit application to EPA on June 30, 2011. After review and resolution of application deficiencies, EPA was able to develop a draft final permit. Stonehaven Energy plans to use the Latshaw #9 as an injection well to dispose of fluids produced in association with their shallow oil and gas production operations in Venango County, PA. Injection will occur into the Speechley formation. The injection well is located in the Tippery Field in Cranberry Township, Venango Township, PA. A permit is required to meet the provisions of the EPA administered UIC Program in Pennsylvania.
