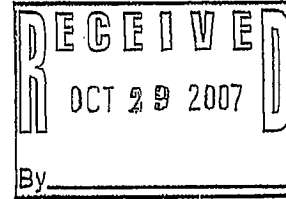

Pursuant to Regulation 1, Rule 110 of the North Coast Unified Air Quality Management District, the Air Pollution Control Officer has made a Preliminary Determination of Compliance and Proposed Conditions to the Pacific Gas and Electric Company for the Humboldt Bay Repowering Project located at 1000 King Salmon Ave., Eureka, CA

The proposed project consists of the installation and operation of 10 Wartsila 18V50DF 16 Megawatt natural gas-fired reciprocating engine-generators at Pacific Gas and Electric's existing Humboldt Bay Power Plant near Eureka, Humboldt County, California. The Humboldt Bay Repowering Project will replace the existing steam boiler units 1 and 2 and the existing peaking turbines (mobile emergency Power Plants 2 and 3.) The nominal plant output after the repowering will be 165 MW.

Written public comments regarding the Preliminary Determination of Compliance and Proposed Conditions can be submitted to the District for a period of thirty (30) days after publication of this notice. Written comments may be mailed, faxed or e-mailed to the District.

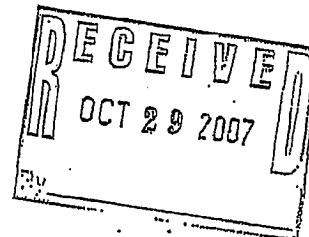
