**JOINT STATUS REPORT AND SECOND MOTION FOR STAY OF  
PROCEEDINGS**

On November 2, 2006, the Town of Marion, Massachusetts (“Permittee”) filed a timely petition for review with the Environmental Appeals Board of NPDES Permit No. MA0100030, which had been reissued by the Environmental Protection Agency-New England Region (“Region”) on October 6, 2006. Upon joint motion by the parties, the EAB rescinded the December 19, 2006 deadline for the Region to file a response to the petition and stayed the appeal until February 19, 2007 to allow the parties to explore the potential for settlement. *See Order Granting Motion for Stay of Proceedings*, dated December 6, 2006.

The Region and the Permittee have successfully concluded a settlement, which will be reflected through a modification to the permit. Pursuant to 40 CFR § 124.19(d), the Region expects to withdraw certain contested conditions and propose a new draft permit modification shortly after the uncontested and severable conditions of the permit become effective on March 1, 2007. *See Notice of Uncontested and Severable Conditions*, dated January 4, 2007. The draft permit modification will be subject to a thirty (30) day notice and comment period in accordance with 40 CFR §§ 124.6 and

124.10. To allow the permit modification proceedings to conclude, the Region and the Permittee respectfully request that the Board continue the stay of proceedings until June 1, 2007, which is approximately ninety (90) days from the effective date of the permit. The Permittee has informed the Region of its assent to this motion.


