

**RESPONDENT'S UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE
RESPONSE TO PETITIONS FOR REVIEW**

Respondent, the United States Environmental Protection Agency, Region III (Region or EPA) hereby files this Motion to extend the time for filing its response to the above-referenced petitions for review by sixty (60) days, until May 13, 2005.

On December 16, 2004, EPA issued the final modified National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Permit No. DC0021199 (Permit) for the Blue Plains Wastewater Treatment Facility to the District of Columbia Water and Sewer Authority (WASA). On January 18, 2005, the Friends of the Earth and the Sierra Club filed a petition to review the modified Permit, designated Appeal No. 05-01. Also on January 18, 2005, the permittee, WASA, filed a petition for review, designated Appeal No. 05-02. By letters dated January 25, 2005, the Board directed the Region to file its Responses to the Petitions on or before March 14, 2005. On

February 23, 2005, the Region filed an unopposed Motion to consolidate these matters. That motion is presently before the Board.


The Permit at issue here is the first Phase II permit EPA has issued under the 1994 Combined Sewer Overflow Control Policy and involves issues of first impression in terms of application of the Policy, particularly in light of the enactment of the Wet Weather Water Quality Act of 2000, which added Section 402(q) to the Clean Water Act, requiring *inter alia*, that all CSO permits conform to the Policy. In addition, the primary EPA Headquarters attorney assigned to the matter has taken an unanticipated early paternity leave and will be unavailable for several weeks. Finally, this extension will allow the parties to determine whether there is any basis upon which to pursue settlement discussions.

EPA has consulted with counsel for Friends of the Earth and Sierra Club and counsel for WASA and neither Petitioner opposes the requested extension of time.

For the foregoing reasons, EPA hereby respectfully moves the Board for an extension of time to file its Response to Appeal Nos. 05-01 and 05-02 until May 13, 2005.
