#### THIRD JOINT MOTION FOR STAY OF PROCEEDINGS AND EXTENSION OF TIME

The Respondent in this proceeding, the United States Environmental Protection Agency Region III ("EPA"); and Petitioners, the Government of the District of Columbia ("DC Government"); the District of Columbia Water and Sewer Authority ("DC WASA"); and Friends of the Earth and Defenders of Wildlife ("FOE/DOW"), collectively, "the Parties," hereby submit this Third Joint Motion for Stay of Proceedings and Extension of Time for EPA to file a response to the Petitioners' petitions ("Response") and certified index to the administrative record. Pursuant to Order of the Environmental Appeals Board ("Board") dated July 18, 2006, EPA's consolidated brief in response to the DC and FOE/DOW's Petitions for Review is currently due October 3, 2006.

As indicated in a previous filing in this matter, the parties engaged in settlement discussions on June 30, 2006. In addition, the parties have met in person on July 19, 2006 and by telephone on September 12, 2006. During all such meetings, the parties have made progress in resolving the issues raised in the individual appeals. The parties are scheduled to reconvene on October 16 and November 9, 2006. Because the parties anticipate that continued settlement discussions will be necessary at least 60 days past October 3, 2006, they hereby jointly move for an additional stay of proceedings and extension to EPA's filing obligations until December 1, 2006 to facilitate continued settlement discussions.
