On August 21, 2018, the Environmental Appeals Board ("EAB") issued a letter to EPA, Region 5 ("Region 5"), offering the Parties in the above referenced case the opportunity to engage in Alternative Dispute Resolution ("ADR"). Region 5 appreciates this opportunity, and Region 5 agrees with the principles of ADR and believes that it is a useful and creative means of achieving equitable resolution to many issues which may come before the EAB.

However, in the present matter, Region 5 must decline the offer of ADR. Unfortunately, Region 5 believes that the nature of a UIC Class II Permit Petitioner challenge, particularly in the present matter, does not offer many alternatives for creative resolution. Based upon the present record, Region 5 elects to move forward with the standard EAB process.
