## SEVENTH JOINT MOTION FOR STAY OF PROCEEDINGS AND EXTENSION OF TIME

Respondent in this proceeding, U.S. EPA Region III ("EPA"), and Petitioners, the Government of the District of Columbia ("DC Government"), the District of Columbia Water and Sewer Authority ("DC WASA"), and Friends of the Earth and Defenders of Wildlife ("FOE/DOW"), collectively, "the Parties," hereby submit this Seventh Joint Motion for Stay of Proceedings and Extension of Time for EPA to file a response to the Petitioners' petitions ("Response") and certified index to the administrative record. Pursuant to an Order of the

Environmental Appeals Board ("Board") dated April 12, 2007, EPA's consolidated brief in response to the DC and FOE/DOW's petitions for review is currently due June 14, 2007.

As described in previous motions in this proceeding, the Parties have held numerous settlement discussions in person and by teleconference. Information exchanges among the parties continue, including a May 30, 2007 submission by EarthJustice, and formal mediation is anticipated during the next 90 days. Accordingly, the parties believe that an additional 90 days is necessary to address the remaining differences on the issues in this proceeding.

Therefore, the parties hereby jointly move for an additional 90-day stay of proceedings and extension to EPA's filing obligations until September 14, 2007 to facilitate continued settlement discussions.
