ORDER SCHEDULING ORAL ARGUMENT

Upon review of the file and the briefs in the above-captioned matter, the Board has decided that oral argument will assist it in its deliberations. In their oral presentations, the parties should, in particular, focus on the following issues raised by the Region and the responses filed by Adams to these issues:

- The Region's argument that Adams waived his right to assert a defense under
 CWA § 404(f) (as stated on pages² 4 to 9 of the Complainant's Notice of Appeal and Supporting Brief).
- 2. The Region's argument that it was materially prejudiced in its preparation for the evidentiary hearing by the late assertion of the 404(f) defense (as stated on pages 7 to 9 of the Complainant's Notice of Appeal and Supporting Brief).

¹ These arguments and issues are identified solely to aid the parties in preparing their presentations and should neither be construed as limiting the issues that the parties can address nor interpreted to suggest that the Board has made any determinations on the merits regarding any of the facts, issues, or legal matters relating to this petition.

3. The Region's argument that the ALJ improperly shifted the burden of proving the

application of CWA § 404(f) to the Region (as stated on pages 11 to 12 of the

Complainant's Notice of Appeal and Supporting Brief).

The parties are hereby advised that oral argument is scheduled to begin at 1:30 p.m. on

Thursday, May 3, 2007, in the Administrative Courtroom, U.S. Environmental Protection

Agency, EPA East Building, Room 1152, 1201 Constitution Avenue, N.W., Washington, D.C.

Each party will have thirty (30) minutes to present argument. The Region shall present its

argument first and may, if it chooses, reserve 5 minutes of the allotted time for rebuttal.

The parties shall notify the Clerk of the Board in writing by April 26, 2007, of the names

of counsel who will present oral argument. Counsel for either of the parties who wish to

participate in this oral argument via the EPA video-conferencing equipment in the

Administrative Courtroom shall contact the Clerk of the Board, at (202) 233-0122, no later than

April 19, 2007, to make arrangements for use of such equipment.
