GENERAL MOTORS CORPORATION'S MOTION TO EXTEND THE TIME FOR FILING ITS SUPPORTING APPELLATE BRIEF

General Motors Corporation ("GM"), through its counsel, submits this Motion to Extend the Time for Filing its Supporting Appellate Brief to accompany its appeal of the March 30, 2006 initial decision in Docket No. RCRA-05-2004-0001. The Environmental Appeals Board ("EAB") "may grant an extension of time for filing any document: upon timely motion of a party to the proceeding, for good cause shown, and after consideration of prejudice to other parties" 40 C.F.R. § 22.7(b).

In the matter of General Motors Automotive-North America, Docket No. RCRA-05-2004-0001, Mr. John M. Kyle, III ("Mr. Kyle") and Mr. Michael T. Scanlon ("Mr. Scanlon") of Barnes & Thornburg, LLP served as counsel for GM. *See* Exhibit 1 at ¶ 1 & 2. On Thursday, April 20, 2006, Mr. Kyle's father passed away after several months of declining health. *See* Exhibit 1 at ¶ 4. On or about April 6, 2006, GM determined it would appeal the March 30, 2006 initial decision in Docket No. RCRA-05-2004-0001. *See* Exhibit 1 at ¶ 5. Although Mr. Kyle served as lead trial counsel in the matter before the Administrative Law Judge, he is unable, due

to the illness and subsequent death of his father, to advise and represent GM in the appeal of this matter. See Exhibit 1 at \P 6. Therefore, on or about April 21, 2006, in-house counsel for GM sought to affiliate additional counsel to serve as co-counsel for GM in its appeal of the March 30, 2006 Initial Decision in Docket No. RCRA-05-2004-0001. See Exhibit 1 at \P 7. On April 25, 2006, EPA counsel in this matter, Mr. James Cha, stated EPA had no objection to GM's request for a ten (10) day extension of time to file the Supporting Appellate Brief in this matter. See Exhibit 1 at \P 8. Immediately thereafter, counsel for GM filed the required Notice of Appeal, Notice of Appearance, and this Motion with the Environmental Appeals Board.

For good cause shown with no objection by counsel for EPA, GM respectfully requests that the EAB grant its Motion to Extend the Time for Filing its Supporting Appellate Brief and allow counsel for GM ten (10) additional days to file the Supporting Appellate Brief. Specifically, GM requests the EAB set a deadline of May 15, 2006 for the filing of GM's Supporting Appellate Brief.¹
