### STATUS REPORT AND MOTION TO EXTEND THE STAY OF PROCEEDINGS

Region 1 of the Environmental Protection Agency ("EPA" or the "Region"), Respondent, respectfully submits to the Environmental Appeals Board ("Board") this status report and motion to extend the stay of proceedings related to the petition for review filed by the Conservation Law Foundation ("CLF") in the above-referenced appeal. The basis for this motion is to allow the parties an additional forty-five (45) days to continue their settlement discussions to resolve the issues raised on appeal, as discussed below. Counsel for CLF and the City of Portsmouth ("City") have assented to this motion.

On April 10, 2007, the Region reissued a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination

System ("NPDES") Permit, No. NH0100234 (the "Permit"), to the City authorizing wastewater

discharges into the Piscataqua River and combined sewer overflow discharges into South Mill

Pond and the Piscataqua River. CLF filed its petition for review with the Board on May 3, 2007,

and the City filed a letter with the Board stating its desire to participate in the proceedings as a party on June 20, 2007.

The Board issued an order on June 27, 2007 which granted the City's request to intervene as a party, and also granted the Region's motion to stay the proceedings until August 31, 2007 to enable the parties to explore settlement of the issues on appeal. On September 5, 2007, the Board granted a second stay of the proceedings until October 16, 2007, based on the parties' progress in negotiations described in the status report that the Region filed on August 31, 2007. The second order directed the parties to provide to the Board, on or before October 16, 2007, a report describing the status of settlement negotiations and suggesting a future course of action.

The parties have continued to have productive negotiations. On September 14, 2007, the City provided its proposal to address interim pollution control measures, and the parties have made significant progress in developing a final plan related to interim measures that could be employed before the new secondary treatment plant is completed. The parties have also made good progress in identifying an approach for developing future nitrogen limits.

The Region, with the assent of counsel for CLF and the City, requests an extension of the stay of proceedings for an additional forty-five (45) days, until Friday, November 30, 2007, to provide time for the parties to continue the discussions aimed at reaching final resolution of the issues on appeal. On or as soon as possible before that date, the parties will submit a status report to advise the Board whether it is appropriate to continue the stay, dismiss the petitions, or

establish a schedule for EPA's and the City's responses to the petition.
