MOTION TO EXTEND STAY OF PROCEEDINGS

The United States Environmental Protection Agency, New England Region ("Region"), with the consent of counsel for the City of Leominster ("City"), respectfully submits to the Environmental Appeals Board ("Board") this Motion to Extend Stay of Proceedings with respect to the above-captioned matter.

On September 28, 2006, the Region reissued NPDES Permit, No. MA0100617 ("Permit"), to the City authorizing discharges from the Leominster Water Pollution Control Facility into the North Nashua River and establishing effluent limitations, monitoring requirements, and other conditions for such discharges. On November 3, 2006, the City filed a petition for review by the Environmental Appeals Board ("Board") contesting the Permit's phosphorus limit of 0.2 mg/l from April 1 – October 31, and the phosphorus limit of 1.0 mg/l from November 1 – March 31. The Board received the petition on November 3, 2006, and directed the Region to respond to the petition no later than January 3, 2007.


On December 14, 2006, the City and the Region jointly moved to stay the proceedings until April 3, 2007, in order to allow the parties to try to resolve the issues on

appeal through settlement negotiations. On December 15, 2006, the Board issued an order staying the proceedings in this matter until April 3, 2007, and directing the parties to submit a Status Report to the Board by February 28, 2007. On February 27, 2007, the Region submitted a Status Report, describing the parties' continued negotiations on the terms of a compliance schedule, and a Motion to Extend the Stay of Proceedings until May 3, 2007. The Board granted the extension of the stay on February 28, 2007.

The parties are close to reaching a final decision as to settlement. Therefore, the Region requests that the Board continue the Stay of Proceedings an additional 35 days (until June 8, 2007). On or as soon as possible before that date, the parties will submit a Status Report to advise the Board of the status of settlement discussions, and whether it is appropriate to continue the stay, dismiss the petition, or establish a schedule for the Region's response to the petition.


