#### FOURTH JOINT MOTION FOR STAY OF PROCEEDINGS AND EXTENSION OF TIME

The Respondent in this proceeding, the United States Environmental Protection Agency Region III ("EPA"); and Petitioners, the Government of the District of Columbia ("DC Government"); the District of Columbia Water and Sewer Authority ("DC WASA"); and Friends of the Earth and Defenders of Wildlife ("FOE/DOW"), collectively, "the Parties," hereby submit this Fourth Joint Motion for Stay of Proceedings and Extension of Time for EPA to file a response to the Petitioners' petitions ("Response") and certified index to the administrative record. Pursuant to Order of the Environmental Appeals Board ("Board") dated September 26, 2006, EPA's consolidated brief in response to the DC and FOE/DOW's Petitions for Review is currently duc Dcccmber 1, 2006.

As indicated in previous filings in this matter, the parties engaged in settlement discussions on June 30, 2006. In addition, the parties have met in person on July 19, 2006 and by telephone on September 12, 2006. Further, the parties have met in person on October 16, 2006, and by teleconference on November 9, 2006. During all such meetings, the parties have made progress toward resolving the issues raised in the individual appeals.

Moreover, the November 7, 2006 election has resulted in a change of administration to the Government of Washington, D.C., with the new elected officials beginning their positions on January 2, 2007. While the parties are scheduled to reconvene on December 11, 2006, they also anticipate that the transition to a new administration will necessitate some additional time for negotiations Accordingly, the parties hereby jointly move for an additional stay of proceedings and extension to EPA's filing obligations until March 1, 2007 to facilitate continued settlement discussions.
