MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

The United States Environmental Protection Agency, ("EPA" or "Agency") Region 5 ("Region") requests that the Environmental Appeals Board ("EAB" or "Board") grant a 30-day extension of time, until April 25, 2024, to file the certified index to the administrative record and relevant portions of the administrative record as well as the Region's response to the Petition for Review in the above-captioned matter.

EPA seeks this extension for the following reasons. The Petition raises legal and technical claims that warrant consultation with multiple divisions in the Agency including headquarters and other regions at the highest management and political levels. In particular, the Petition's claims concerning the National Environmental Policy Act ("NEPA"), 42 U.S.C. §§ 4321-4370, are similar to claims raised in *In Re Powertech (USA) Inc.*, UIC Appeal No. 20-01, (filed Dec. 24, 2020), currently pending before the Board. To address the Petition's claims in full and ensure the Board has the full benefit of the Agency's position on this issue under different permit appeals, the Region plans to coordinate with multiple attorneys in several specialized disciplines within the Region and across the Agency. Additionally, the

administrative records for the permits are voluminous and contain personally identifiable

information that the Region plans to redact and handle securely. The Region respectfully

requests an additional 30 days in consideration of these circumstances.

Consistent with 40 C.F.R. § 124.19(f)(2), the Region has consulted with Petitioners and

the Permittee Wabash Carbon Services and has been informed that neither one objects to or

opposes this motion for extension of time.

For the reasons stated above, The Region respectfully requests that the EAB grant a 30-

day extension of time to April 25, 2024, for the Region to file its Response to the Petition for

review, including the responsive brief, certified index of the administrative record, and the

relevant portions of the administrative record.
