JOINT MOTIONS FOR STAY OF PROCEEDINGS, EXTENSION OF TIME AND CONSOLIDATION OF PROCEEDINGS

The Respondent in this proceeding, the United States Environmental Protection Agency Region III ("EPA"); and Petitioners, the Government of District of Columbia ("DC Government"); the District of Columbia Water and Sewer Authority ("DC WASA"); and Friends of the Earth and Defenders of Wildlife ("FOE/DOW") collectively, "the Parties," hereby submit this Joint Motion for Stay of Proceedings and Extension of Time for EPA to file a response to the Petitioners' petitions ("Response") and certified index to the administrative record. Currently,

the Response to the DC Government Petition is due May 29, 2006, and the Response to the FOE/DOW Petition is due June 5, 2006.

The Parties move for a sixty-day stay of proceedings and extension to EPA's filing obligations until August 4, 2006 to facilitate settlement discussions among the parties.

Further, the Parties hereby move to consolidate the above-captioned proceedings because both appeals relate to the same amendment of NPDES Permit No. DC 0000221, and consolidation would facilitate more efficient processing of the two petitions. The parties move for consolidation solely for the purpose of economy and administrative convenience, and without waiver of any rights, claims or defenses.
