**UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF DATE FOR ORAL ARGUMENT**

Permittee Veolia ES Technical Solutions, L.L.C. (“Veolia”), by and through its undersigned counsel, respectfully requests that the Environmental Appeals Board (“Board”) grant this Unopposed Motion for Extension of Date for Oral Argument and enter an order moving the date for oral argument from **Thursday, March 5, 2020** to a later date on or after **Wednesday, April 1, 2020**.<sup>1</sup>

On January 17, 2020, the Board entered its Order Scheduling Oral Argument to assist the Board in its deliberations for the above-captioned appeal of Veolia’s Title V permit issued by Region 5 of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (“Region 5”). Veolia’s counsel, Joseph M. Kellmeyer, who will present oral argument on Veolia’s behalf, will be in Chiang Mai, Thailand on a pre-planned and pre-paid trip on March 5, 2020, leaving from St. Louis on February 28, 2020 and arriving back in St. Louis on March 9, 2020. An extension of the date for

oral argument would therefore allow Mr. Kellmeyer to adequately prepare for and present oral argument before the Board.

Veolia represents that counsel for the Petitioner American Bottom Conservancy and counsel for Region 5 do not oppose this motion. Counsel for Region 5 further represented to Mr. Kellmeyer that Region 5 has coordinated with the appropriate offices and does not oppose moving the date for oral argument.

WHEREFORE, Veolia respectfully requests that the Board grant Veolia's Unopposed Motion for Extension of Date for Oral Argument and enter an order extending the date of oral argument to a date on or after **Wednesday, April 1, 2020**.
