**MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO RESPOND TO THE PETITIONS FOR
REVIEW AND SUPPLEMENTAL BRIEFS**

Desert Rock Energy Company, LLC ("Desert Rock"), the permittee in this matter, moves for a 35-day extension of time (until January 8, 2009) to submit its response to the petitions for review, supplemental briefs, amicus curiae brief, and New Mexico's recent motion to supplement the administrative record. On December 1, 2008, the Board granted a 35-day extension of time to the United States Environmental Protection Agency, Region 9, and the Diné Power Authority to respond to these same pleadings. Desert Rock requests this additional time to ensure an orderly presentation of argument in this proceeding, and to further explore the implications of the Board's decision in *In re Deseret Power Electric Cooperative*, PSD Appeal No. 07-03, which was issued on November 13, 2008, and New Mexico's recent motion to supplement the administrative record.


