

## MOTION FOR LEAVE TO FILE A BRIEF AS AMICI CURIAE

Pursuant to 40 C.F.R § 124.19 and Environmental Appeals Board Practice Manual § III.D.7, the Indiana Municipal Power Agency, the Missouri Joint Municipal Electric Utility Commission, the Northern Illinois Municipal Power Agency, Soyland Power Cooperative, Inc., Wolverine Power Supply Cooperative, Inc., and the Kentucky Municipal Power Agency (the "Public Power Participants") hereby move for leave to file an amici curiae brief in connection with the petition for review filed by American Bottom Conservancy, American Lung Association of Metropolitan Chicago, Clean Air Task Force, Health and Environmental Justice-St. Louis, Lake County Conservation Alliance, Sierra Club and Valley Watch ("Petitioners"). The petition for review challenges the decision by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency ("IEPA") to issue a Prevention of Significant Deterioration ("PSD") permit to Prairie State Generating Company, LLC ("Prairie State") for the construction of a 1,500 MW coal-fired electric generating station ("Prairie State Generating Station") in Washington County, Illinois.

The Public Power Participants have committed to acquire, in total, a 47 percent undivided ownership interest in the Prairie State Generating Station and its electric output. That output is a major element of the Public Power Participants' plans to provide economical and reliable electric

power to their customers near the end of this decade and beyond. For that reason, the Public Power Participants respectfully request that the Board grant leave to file an amici brief explaining their need for an expeditious conclusion to this proceeding. The Public Power Participants' brief is enclosed for the Board's consideration, should this motion be granted. All correspondence regarding this matter should be served on the undersigned.
