## U.S. ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY STATUS REPORT

In the April 27, 2016 Order, the EAB directed the parties to file a status report (jointly or separately) beginning October 1, 2016, and continuing every three months (i.e., on or around January 1, April 1, July 1, October 1 of each year) advising the Board of the status of District Court litigation.
