### MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE RESPONSE

NOW COMES the Respondent, ILLINOIS ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION

AGENCY ("Illinois EPA"), by and through its attorneys, and moves the

ENVIRONMENTAL APPEALS BOARD ("Board") for an extension of the time to file a

Response to the Petition for Review (hereinafter "Petition") filed by the Petitioners,

SIERRA CLUB ("Sierra Club"), et al. in the above-captioned matter.

- Petitioners filed their Petition with the Board on or about November 14,
   2003, seeking a review of a PSD permit determination by the Illinois EPA involving
   INDECK-ELWOOD, LLC, ("Indeck-Elwood"). The Board received the Petition on
   November 17, 2003.
- The Clerk of the Board sent a copy of the Petition, together with a cover letter detailing instructions for responding to the appeal, to the Illinois EPA on November 20, 2003. The Illinois EPA received the materials on November 26, 2003.
- 3. By the instructions contained in the Board's cover letter, the Illinois EPA was requested to file a formal Response to the Petition, including any relevant excerpts from the administrative record. If summary disposition is sought, the Response was due with the Board by no later than December 5, 2003. If a more detailed response to the

merits of the petition is sought, the Response was due with the Board by no later than December 22, 2003.

- 4. At this juncture, the Illinois EPA anticipates that a few of the issues raised in the Petition may present possible grounds for summary disposition. However, it is also anticipated that several of the issues will be addressed with a detailed response to their respective merits.
- 5. The undersigned attorney was assigned the responsibilities for handling this case matter on or about December 5, 2003, but has been unable to devote any substantial time or resources to the Illinois EPA's Response due to the press of other enforcement-related case assignments.
- 6. As a result of the delays occasioned by other case assignments and the breadth of the issues raised in the Petition, the undersigned attorney expects that a Response will require at least five or six weeks to prepare and finalize.
- Accordingly, the Illinois EPA formally requests an extension of time of 45
   days in which to file its formal Response with the Board
- 8. The grant of this extension of the filing date will ensure that the Response will fully address all of the technical issues raised by the Petitioners in their appeal. In addition, an extension of this time period will not result in any hardship or prejudice to the Petitioners.

WHEREFORE, the Illinois EPA respectfully requests that the Board grant this

Motion for Extension of Time to File Response to thereby allow the filing of the

Response to be served with the Board no later than Thursday, February 5, 2004
