MOTION OF PETITIONER ALASKA ESKIMO WHALING COMMISSION TO WITHDRAW FROM THESE PROCEEDINGS

Alaska Eskimo Whaling Commission (AEWC) hereby moves the board for leave to withdraw from these proceedings. On October 24, 2011, AEWC and the Iñupiat Community of the Arctic Slope (ICAS) filed a joint Petition for Review of two major source air permits that where issued to Shell Offshore Inc. and Shell Gulf of Mexico, Inc. (hereafter Shell). Docket No. 7. The AEWC Commissioners have since decided not to pursue this administrative appeal. *See* Letter from Johnny Aiken, AEWC Executive Director to Chris Winter & Tanya Sanerib, Crag Law Center (November 14, 2011) (Exhibit 1). As a result, AEWC respectfully requests that the Board grant it leave to withdraw from this matter.
