Dear Clerk of the EAB.

Last Thursday, March 8, 2007, the signed document was sent (twice) to the attention of the EAB, to the ALJ, and to both EPA's attorneys; I have confirmation reports for all of the above transmissions. Afterwards, that Thursday in the early afternoon, hard copies were also sent to all the parties to this litigation: EAB's original and five copies sent via FEDEX, and enough copies for the rest of the parties, including the ALJ, EPA's Hearing Clerk, and EPA's attorneys Ms. Fidler and Mr. Quintana, sent USPS (certified mail, return receipt requested), as I already informed you last Friday afternoon. Please let me know when the FEDEX parcel arrives at your office, and the reason given for the delay.
