Intervenor Shell Offshore, Inc.'s, December 30, 2009 motion to file an oversized brief in support of the urgent motion "for a determination that petitioners are not entitled to a stay pending review" is granted. Intervenor's urgent motion and the joinders thereto are denied as unnecessary as petitioners have not filed a motion for stay. The January 6, 2010 motions for leave file amicus briefs in support of intervenor's motion are also denied as unnecessary. In light of this order, petitioners' request for an extension of time to respond to intervenor's motion is denied as unnecessary.

Petitioners' motions to expedite review of these petitions are granted. The provisions of Ninth Circuit Rule 31-2.2(a) shall not apply to these petitions. No extensions of time to submit the parties' briefs will be entertained. The consolidated record shall be filed by January 25, 2010; the consolidated opening

brief(s) shall be filed by February 23, 2010; the consolidated answering brief and intervenors' briefs shall be filed by March 25, 2010; and the optional consolidated reply brief(s) shall be filed by April 19, 2010. The Clerk shall calendar these petitions in May 2010.

All parties on a side are encouraged to join in a single brief to the greatest extent practicable. *See* 9th Cir. R. 28-4.
