1 to his health problems. I am concerned that air pollution from the facility is making, and
2 will continue to make, his health problems worse.

3 7. For the past five years, my seven-year-old daughter has been attending gymnastics
4 lessons in a warehouse located about one-half mile away from Irvington Generating
5 Station. You can see the large facility from the gym. When my daughter and her
6 classmates train, they breathe air that is polluted by emissions from the power plant.

7 8. This summer ozone levels in Tucson violated federal health standards. Emissions
8 of nitrogen oxides (NO_x) contribute to elevated levels of ozone. I am concerned that an
9 increase in emissions of NO_x from the Irvington Generating Station will increase ozone
10 levels in the Tucson area that will be harmful to my health and the health of my family.

11 9. I am extremely concerned that pollution from the Irvington Generating Station is
12 harming the health of my family and my own health. We cannot avoid breathing air
13 polluted by ozone, particulate matter, NO_x and other air pollution from, or caused by the
14 facility, and we are exposed to this pollution every day. I am very concerned that air
15 pollution from the power plant has harmed and will continue to harm our health, and that
16 this pollution will cause us long-term health problems.

17 10. I believe that the Irvington Generating Station harms the health of the people living
18 in my community, including my family and friends. I am participating in this action
19 because I am worried about how pollution from the facility affects my family, friends, and
20 community.

21 11. I declare under penalty of perjury under the laws of the United States of America
22 that the foregoing is true and correct.
