Dam removal is reviving itself once again, with the Army Corps having held a public meeting in Stow last night, and in Maynard about a week ago.

They've concluded they completed their review of the Assabet River, and all dams can/should stay with one exception: the Ben Smith Dam on the Maynard-Stow town line.

One must never be provincial of course, or a typical NIMBY citizen re programs benefiting others while one is being disadvantaged. But, since there are worthy exceptions to this rule, Maynard and Stow will not take down the dam if they have any say in the matter, and neither will my Clock Tower Place colleagues and I.

What I'd suggest is a second invitation to Barbara Blumeris (sp.) of the Army Corps, re a second visit with our Steering Committee regarding her agency's findings and conclusions AND impacts. Her agency's report will bring good news to the other communities on the Assabet River that are interested in keeping their dams. But Stow and Maynard will be a different story.
